Background

Medications and vaccines have transformed disease prevention and treatment. However, they can also cause undesirable and unexpected side effects. Pharmacovigilance is the science and activities relating to the detection, assessment, understanding and prevention of adverse effects or any other drugrelated problem The post-marketing assessment of medicines plays a key role for better defining drugs' safety profile in real-world setting and filling the evidence gap of pre-marketing studies.

Recent health emergencies have highlighted the need for the assessment, detection and prevention of the risks in the use of products for off-label purposes and those with accelerated approvals, but also the need for proper risk communication and support for patients that may be affected by adverse drug reactions. Moreover, pharmacovigilance in Asia has been a constant challenge due to varied geographical, cultural and medical practices in these regions.
